


Made in USA INDY 6000 - High Current 28 VDC Power Station

The INDY 6000 is a 5760 watt hour battery power station. The Indy 6000 can provide up to 6000 watts or 125 Amps of 28V DC Power. Designed for high powered LED Lights, the Indy 6000 is portable, light weight, linkable and easy to transport. The Indy 6000 has a convenient **built in charger** and the ability to customize outputs based on the applications. The built in diagnostics allow the owner to determine the weakest cartridge bank after every discharge. The Indy 6000 is a rugged build intended for rental house owners that service and maintain their own equipment. Optional proprietary service module is available for maintaining the Indy 6000 in top shape.

INDY 6000 Features

1 ON/OFF Power Switch:

Switch MUST be turned ON first to enable the VDC output power for each block.

2 Empty Check Switch:

When turned **ON**, check status of battery power for each block.

3 22-30 VDC Output:

One 28 VDC Output @ 20 Amps.

Volts	Connector Type
24V	3-Pin XLR, Arri Standard (Pin 1 Gnd, Pin 2 Bat +)

4 120 Amp VDC Output:

One 28 VDC Output @ 120 Amps.

5 125 Amp Circuit Breaker:

28.8 VDC - Protection from power surges for each block.

6 Digital Power Meter: Monitors each specific battery block.

7 Charger Input:

Fuse: 10 amp. 90-240 VAC 50/60 Hz 500 watts per block

8 Battery Block Status:

 Provides charge status of each block.
 When status button pushed on an empty battery, the display will tell which of the 9 banks caused the block to shut off on each block

9 8000 Watt Inverter:

Provides pure sine wave AC power up to 8000 watts. Available in 120 VAC or 240 VAC.

Inverter can be located on front of battery block using provided hangers or on back of hand truck as shown.

Short Term INDY 3000 Storage (Up to 1 Week): • 5°C to 25°C (41°E to 77°E)

After depleting an Indy 6000 Battery, it is best to charge battery within a week.

Long Term INDY 3000 Storage (More than 1 Week):

- 5°C to 25°C (41°F to 77°F)
- Fully charge battery
- No output devices connected
 Recharge every 3 months
